

SK Fall Soccer Registration Process

Passport or Birth Certificate:

A copy of a valid passport or birth certificate is required upon registration under WSYSA rules and regulations. Your registration is not complete without it. Please fax, scan & email, or walk-in this piece of paperwork. We do not recommend regular mailing this piece of paperwork nor do we guarantee its safe arrival if regular mailed.

Placement:

We place all soccer players by age rather than grade. Please reference Washington State Youth Soccer Association's (WSYSA) 2009-2010 age bracket for assistance.

Registration:

Returning Player Registration will run May 6th – 27th) to guarantee placement on the same team from fall 2008.

Registrations received after 5pm May 27th will be processed after the rush on Open Player Registration Day (May 29th)

We will not be accepting any registrations on May 28th, the day between Returning and Open Player Registration, so we can finalize rosters prior to adding new players. Open Player Registration is when new players may begin to register. If you have a specific team request, please note this on your registration. This is not a guarantee that there is a spot open on your requested team. For this reason, please provide alternate placement preferences on your registration.

Transfer Players:

If a player wants to transfer to a different team (and played soccer with SKYC/SKSC in fall of 2008), he/she must fill out a Player Movement form available online at skyc.net (under "Administration" on the homepage) and it will be processed the night before Open Registration. That player will go on the team he/she requested to be transferred to if there is room. If there is not room he/she will go back on his/her fall 2008 team unless a request is made on the Movement form otherwise.

**If we do not have a birth certificate or valid passport on file, we must receive it prior to Open Registration or you may lose your spot (no hospital certificates can be accepted). If a player played fall soccer 2008 or spring soccer 2009 we may have this paperwork on file and do not need to have it turned in again. Parents: please check with our office and see if we have it on file. While this is a required piece of paperwork, many of our U7s and U8s from last season did not turn this in. We were most stringent about receiving this piece of paperwork from U9s and above, as those age groups are slowly nearing WSYSA sanctioning—when this paperwork will need to be in line per WSYSA rules and regulations, no exceptions. Players, U9 and up, will not be permitted at games without this piece of paperwork on file at our office.

Online Registration:

Online registration at www.skyc.net is the easiest and quickest way to register, (or you may come to the office located at 700 Main Street, #111, Edmonds, WA 98020).

If you register online please make sure you receive an email confirmation--if you do not, please contact the office ASAP. The email confirmation is your receipt of registration, and if you do not receive one, the office may not have as well. No over the phone, faxed, or emailed registrations will be accepted. We are open M-F 8:30-5.

DISCOUNTS/SCHOLARSHIPS:

Multiple Child discounts are as follows (this is for **SKYC**, not U11 and up/SKSC):

1st and 2nd child is full price

3rd child receives a \$30 discount

4th child is free

Scholarships are available. You may find the Scholarship form online under "Administration," but must come in to the office to turn this paperwork in and be processed.

REFUNDS:

A \$25 NON-REFUNDABLE PROCESSING FEE IS PART OF OUR REFUND POLICY. Refunds are issued on the 15th and 30th of every month. A Refund Request Form is needed in order to process this request and is available on our homepage under 'Administration.' Please reference this form, which outlines our entire refund policy.

OTHER:

*On the first day of registration, in person registrations will be placed first and onliners will be placed after the morning rush.

*New Players who register during the Returning Player registration period will be placed after the morning rush of Open Registration day.

*Transfers who register online and do not provide follow-up paperwork (Player Movement Form) will be the last transfers added to teams.

*Players may play up an age group, but under no circumstances may they play down. Please reference the age bracket above before registering. If you are registering to play up an age group, you must do so in person only.

*Roster spots will not be held for unpaid players, nor do we provide payment plans.

*The "U" stands for "under." Ie; U11=Under 11 years old, etc...
